AUDITION REQUIRMENTS

Saxophones/Trumpets/Trombones:

Scales: Play in order as noted on scale sheets. Scales need to be performed two octaves from memory at QN=120.

Sight-reading: Students are allowed 30 seconds to study both sight-reading examples at the indicated tempo. After 30 seconds, give tempo and allow student to start.

Piano/Bass/Guitar/Vibes:

Scales: Play in order as noted on scale sheets. With both hands playing simultaneously in octaves, they should be performed through a range of two octaves from memory at QN=120.

Sight-reading: Students are allowed 30 seconds to study both sight-reading examples at the indicated tempo. After 30 seconds, students will be given tempo and allowed to start. Both etudes will have a playback mp3 file.

Drum Set:

Time-Keeping: Student will demonstrate the following styles using light fills (16 Bars Each): Medium Swing w/sticks & w/brushes; Shuffle; Samba; Bossa Nova; Ballad w/Brushes; Up-Tempo Swing w/sticks & with brushes.

Sight-reading: Students are allowed 30 seconds to study both sight-reading examples at the indicated tempo. After 30 seconds, students will be given tempo and allowed to start. Both etudes will have a playback mp3 file.
